BE PART OF THE SOLUTION

Employment plays a central role in life and helps form a person's sense of identity and self-worth. In addition to financial independence, work gives us purpose and connects us to those around us. Society, however, can stigmatize people living with mental illness, making it challenging to find or maintain a job.

Independence Center's Clubhouse, a psychosocial rehabilitation program, partners with top St. Louis corporations and business owners to meet their employment needs. Our Clubhouse program is one of 350 such programs world-wide.

Independence Center's employment program is designed to remove obstacles and provide individualized support so that members have success on the job.

HOW WE PREPARE OUR MEMBERS FOR WORK

Independence Center Clubhouse is organized around a structured system called the work ordered day. The work ordered day parallels the typical business hours and functions of the working community. Our members come to the Clubhouse each day to volunteer in a variety of jobs that are essential to the operation of the Clubhouse.

We believe in the dignity of work and know that work is one of the best ways to develop a sense of worth and value. In our program, members go from isolation to community and learn to manage their symptoms. They understand what is needed and expected at a job and develop a strong sense of responsibility to it.

TRANSITIONAL EMPLOYMENT

Fully-trained part-time employees and guaranteed job coverage

Recruiting and training are one of the highest costs within an organization. Our Transitional Employment (TE) program solves this problem with fully trained, supported part-time employees.

We even guarantee job coverage in the event our member is unable to make it to work.

Transitional Employment positions are designed to be time-limited so that once a member has completed the six to nine month position they have the confidence to obtain a permanent job in the field of their choice.

This provides another member an opportunity to take their place and be trained by Independence Center staff.

EMPLOYMENT CHANGES LIVES

Mark Brodz, Independence Center Member

My name is Mark and I've been a member of Independence Center since November of 2009. I didn't come to the Independence Center on a winning streak.

I was broke, homeless, and just out of one of my many hospitalizations for mental health issues and suicide attempts. Like many people with mental illness, I had been struggling to get well for a very long time with many failed attempts at a correct diagnosis and medication.

Originally, all I wanted from the Clubhouse was computer access and a job. As far as doing anything for anybody else, forget about it – that was my mind set at the time. Sadly, this mindset persisted for 5 years and it was painful – for everyone.

In 2014, Dr. Charles Conway with Independence Center's Health Group correctly diagnosed my illness and put me on a medication regimen that works for me. He also prescribed other non-negotiable actions to take. Some actions included daily attendance at the Clubhouse and involvement in the work ordered day.

So, I attended the morning meeting where we volunteered for jobs. Cleaning bathrooms is a humbling experience. It can also be humorous with some surprising encounters – trust me.

Looking back, that is where my darkness started to lift - cleaning toilets with the staff, side by side. That, my friends, is real teamwork and relationship building. Eventually, I started giving tours and found out that there was more that the Clubhouse had to offer.

I started attending the employment meetings in search of a job. Fall of 2017, a TE was opening at one of our employment partners, Equifax Workforce Solutions. Never at 55 years old did I think I would be an intern, but it worked for Robert De Niro in "The Intern," so I gave it a shot.

A few months into my TE job, my boss and I had a talk. I explained my plans for getting off of disability and that I wanted full-time employment. She asked if I would consider Equifax. I said of course and that I had been looking at the job openings, but, even though I had a degree, it didn't look like I had the qualifications or experience listed for the positions. She smiled and said, no one knows how to do what we do until we train you.

As my TE position was ending, I was able to secure full-time employment as an Unemployment Insurance Specialist at Equifax. Now, I am a Senior Client Service Representative.

Today, I have a compass and direction in life. Independence Center, Dr. Conway, and the medical team saved my life and Equifax has given me a lifestyle I didn't think was going to be possible again.

I have been a member at Independence Center for two years, and so many things have changed.

Before coming in, I was in a dark and gloomy place. I was doing nothing with my life but eating and sleeping. That was my life for 24 years.



I didn't see anything in myself until I came to Independence Center.

On June 5th 2017, my life changed drastically for the better. That day, at Independence Center, I was introduced to a place that brought the life I have today into existence.

Things really started changing when I started to attend the Clubhouse. I was just here to go to Weight Watchers classes, but getting more involved in the unit was what really changed things.

I didn't know that I had skills and potential to succeed, but the Clubhouse showed me that I did. It's amazing when someone tells you that you do something well. Coming to the Clubhouse has boosted my confidence and given me purpose in life. It gave me something to do other than sleep. I built a routine at the Clubhouse and it gave me skills that I could use in the real world.

Eventually, I got my first TE at Panera and completed a six month position.

Immediately following, I accepted my second TE at Rx Outreach and completed a nine month position. What I like about Rx Outreach is that it teaches you to give to others, because it's a non-profit organization. It's helping people in need, and I love helping people.

One of the things that I enjoy most about working is the relationships that I build with my coworkers and my employers. There is a whole other world out there that I didn't know about before Independence Center.

I like having a routine and schedule, being expected somewhere at a certain time, and being relied upon to complete a certain task. Now, I'm doing things that I never thought I could achieve.
